GENERAL INFORMATION

Bayberry Riding Center is located on 50 acres in historic Spotsylvania County, Virginia. Director/Owner Sean Haggerty has operated the riding center since 1972, and has provided a quality camping experience for hundreds of girls for 36 years. Trained in the U.S., Japan and Germany, Haggerty has more than 40 years of experience as a riding instructor.



Bayberry Riding Center operates a year round, full-scale riding program. Our students compete in combined training and dressage.

Bayberry Summer Day Camp is an extension of our riding program for eight weeks of the summer. The camp operated for 34 years as a residential camp, transitioning in 2008 to a day camp.

Bayberry Summer Day Camp can accommodate up to 20 girls, ages seven to 15.

We teach all levels, from the beginner rider who has never been on a horse through the advanced rider who has previous instruction and show experience. Instruction extends beyond the riding arena to all areas of horsemanship, including horse care and stable management.



The day camp operates 8:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday through Friday.

ADDITIONAL ACTIVITIES

Other activities offered each day include swimming, archery, and arts and crafts. Our swimming, archery and art programs are taught by trained and competent counselors.

In addition to Sean Haggerty, the primary riding instructor, the camp has a staff of seven, providing an excellent counselor to camper ratio. We strive for



individual care, which can be important if it is your child's first year at summer camp.

Each child will have a bunk in the dorm and space to keep her riding gear and other clothing needed during the session.

We also have badminton, pingpong and other games for campers to enjoy during free time.

LUNCH

Campers are responsible for bringing their own lunches.



TUITION

Tuition is \$300 per week. A \$100 non-refundable deposit is required when registering, and is credited to your tuition balance. **The balance is due by June 15.**
